

GENERAL RULES, CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current Federation rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Entry forms: Care should be taken to enter each horse in its proper section or class. Exhibitors are responsible for their errors and those of their agents in making out entry forms.

Entry forms must. . .

- Be signed by the exhibitor, rider, driver, handler, coach (if applicable) and trainer or agent. In the case of a rider under 18, his/her parent or guardian, or if not available, the trainer must sign an entry on the minor's behalf.
- Show the mailing address and phone number of owner and trainer.
- Include all current USEF membership numbers (or pay \$30 nonmember registration fee) for each owner, lessee, agent, trainer, coach and rider.
- Include USHJA horse registration number
- Include additional membership numbers and birthdates of junior and amateur riders as required per section or class specifications.

Include with your entry. . .

- Copy of junior hunter and pony measurement cards
- Copy of USEF and USHJA membership cards
- Your check or credit card number

Closing of Entries / Post Entries: Entries for Spring Hunter/Jumper Show close March 7; Mothers Day Spring Classic close April 18. Post entries accepted after that date and during the show at regular fees plus \$25 per horse. Substitutions or transfers allowed at \$5 per horse and/or rider per class. No gate adds on Sunday please.

Returned Checks: Checks returned by the bank for any reason will incur a \$50 charge, and will be re-deposited. In case the check is returned a second time, to retain entries all fees plus penalties must be paid by money order, cashier's check or cash prior to 4 p.m. the day before the show. In the event a check is returned by the bank after the completion of the show, it will be handled in accordance with USEF GR913.

Cancellation and Refunds. Exhibitors canceling after the closing date of entries shall forfeit their entry fees, except in the case of disability of entry. Should an entry be unable to compete due to illness or injury, a refund will be made upon presentation to the show secretary a certificate from a veterinarian (on official letterhead) prior to the first class in which the horse is entered. No refunds of entries shall be made after the start of the show unless the veterinarian certificate is issue by the official show veterinarian and a refund form filled out in the show office. Refunds will cover only those classes in which the horse has not yet competed. In either case, a \$50 scratch fee will be retained. There will be no refund of stall or tack room fees.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other

likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

USEF membership statement. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

USEF membership requirement. All participants (rider, driver, handler, owner, trainer, manager, coach, agent or lessee) must present to the show secretary a current U.S. Equestrian Federation membership card or copy thereof., or if not a member pay a \$30 nonmember registration. Membership may be obtained online at USEF.org, or at the show.

USHJA membership requirement. In order to compete in hunter, hunter breeding, pony hunter breeding, junior hunter, or pony hunter classes at licensed competitions as an exhibitor, rider, trainer or agent, a person must be a member of the U.S. Hunter Jumper Assoc., or pay a \$30 nonmember fee to the USHJA. Classes listed in GR901.9 or GR207.2.i are exempt.

USHJA horse registration. Starting December 1, 2008, in order to compete in hunter, hunter breeding, jumper or hunter seat equitation classes (except those listed in GR901, items 1-9), at licensed competitions, every horse must be registered with the USHJA for a one-time fee of \$30. Horses currently possessing a USEF Lifetime Recording as of November 30, 2008, will be grandfathered into the USHJA Registration Program using their current Recording number. Only one registration number will be issued per horse and must remain with the horse throughout its career.

--Members will still have the option of recording their horses either annually or with a lifetime recording with the USEF if they are interested in accruing points for HOTY, Zone and Foundation awards and to accrue points on the USEF Computer Ranking List.

--Each horse will be assigned a USHJA Registration number and anytime you obtain a USEF horse recording, the same number will be used.

--If a horse currently has a USEF Horse ID number, upon payment of the \$30 registration fee to USHJA, that number will become its USHJA Horse Registration Number.

--Members who choose to annually record their horses with the USEF will need to obtain a USHJA Registry number, which will be the same as their current horse recording number.

Amateur certification. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs must possess current amateur certification issued by USEF. This certification must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the show secretary at least one hour prior to such class, an application for certification. Juniors who have not reached their 18th birthday are amateurs and do not require certification. There is no fee for amateur certification for Senior Active or Life Members. An annual fee of \$30 is charged to individuals who are not members of USEF or Equine Canada.

Measurement cards. Those possessing Federation measurement cards shall have them available when picking up entry numbers, or submit a photocopy with entries. Those competing in junior hunters, hunter ponies and jumper ponies who do not have a measurement card must present the animal for measurement on Friday at 10:00 a.m. Location will be posted in the office.

Coach. For purposes of these rules, a coach is defined as any adult or adults who receives remuneration for having or sharing the responsibility for instructing, teaching, schooling, or advising a rider, driver, handler or vaulter in equestrian skills.

Federation / Drug fee. A \$15 fee will be charged for each horse in performance and/or equitation classes (\$7 equine drug and medication fee to provide for research, inspection and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs). Exception: horses entered in classes exempted from the Equine Drug and Medication fee are also exempt from the balance of the Federation fee. A \$2 USHJA Zone fee will be charged for each horse in performance and/or equitation classes. To be remitted to USHJA in accordance with GR1210.14.

Protective headgear. It is compulsory for all riders in hunter, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials) / SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A show committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required. All juniors riding in hunter, jumper and hunter seat equitation sections, while riding anywhere on the competition grounds, must wear properly fitted protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

Protests. Any rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, exhibitor, owner, agent, trainer or parent of a junior exhibitor, or any life, senior or junior member present at the competition may file a protest with the show committee of a licensed competition or with the Federation hearing committee alleging violation of any Federation rule(s). The protest must be a) in writing; b) signed by the protester; c) addressed to show committee of the competition at which the alleged violation occurred, or to the hearing committee; d) accompanied by a deposit of \$200 if made by a Federation member or parent of a junior exhibitor member, or \$300 if made by a nonmember; e) received by the steward, member of the show committee, competition manager or secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation. If made directly to the hearing committee, the protest must be received at the Federation office by the 10th business day following the last recognized day of the competition, or by the 10th business day following the date on which the alleged violation occurred if it occurred other than at a licensed competition.

Motorized vehicles: In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. **The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from that operation.** Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Eligibility. To be eligible for a stake class, the horse must have been entered, shown and judged in at least one over fences class in that section.

Awards will be given to first place and ribbons to eight places in hunter and equitation classes; to six places in jumper. Awards also to section champions and reserves.

Premium checks. Prize money will be paid by check made payable to the owner listed on the entry form and mailed to the owner within thirty (30) days after the close of the show. Prize money in all classes, excluding Welcome Jumpers, Mini Prix and \$10,000 Jumper Classic, will be divided 30%, 25%, 20%, 15%, 10%.

Addbacks. In classes with addbacks, prize money is computed from the number of horses that actually show. Horses entered but not showing will forfeit their addback money.

Schooling. There is a mandatory office/grounds fee of \$40. The arena will be available for schooling rounds on Tuesday from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Protective headgear must be worn while jumping.

Haul-in Schooling. Those who haul in for schooling day will pay \$125 per horse and must sign a release waiver.

Haul-in fee: Horses hauling in for the day to show and not purchasing a stall will be charged \$50 per day.

Non showing horse fee: Horses stabled during the week but not showing will be charged \$25 per week.

Feed. Hay and grain will be available for purchase at local feed stores.

Dogs. All dogs must be under leash control at all times.

Sharps. Sharps containers will be placed in convenient places in the stabling area. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

Arenas, warm-up areas. Competition arenas are indoors. Spring Hunter/Jumper Show arena is 100 x 200 feet, with Lightfoot footing. Mother's Day Classic arena is 116 x 285 feet., with dirt and sand footing. Schooling and warm-up areas are dirt and sand footing.

Stabling. Box stalls with full doors are provided. Stalls are available from 1:00 p.m. Monday through 9 p.m. Sunday. Stalls and tack rooms for the duration of the show are \$185. Day stalls, if available, are \$50 per day. Bag shavings are available for purchase.

RV hookups. RV hookups for the duration of the show are available at \$200 per RV.

Horse show office. The show office will be open Tuesday from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.; Wednesday through Sunday from half an hour prior to start of session until close of show.

Changes. Management reserves the right to make changes of arenas, judges or class order to facilitate time schedule and conditions, or to cancel or combine any unfilled classes after due notice to exhibitors.

Special Classes.

\$10,000 Jumper Classic must have at least 12 entries to run. The Welcome Jumper class and the Mini Prix must have at least 8 entries to run. The USHJA National Hunter Classic must have at least 10 entries to run.

Order of Go: The order of go will be drawn. In the jump-off, if any, all horses will go in the original drawn order.

Attire: Formal attire is required in all special classes.

Trophy and Ribbons: Trophy to first, ribbons 1-8 in special classes unless otherwise stated.

Team NW Medal Finals will be held at **Oregon Summer**. To be eligible for the Finals, riders must have competed in a Hillcrest Medal of the same section prior to the final.

Team NW Starter Medal: Open to horses and ponies with junior or amateur riders. No cross entry into any other Hillcrest Medal. Course will include two tests (1-9). No combinations. Fences 2'6".

Team NW Children's Medal: Course will include two tests (1-19). Fences 3'. No cross entry into the 3'6" Hillcrest Medal.

Team NW Adult Medal: Course will include two tests (1-19). Fences 3'. No cross entry into the 3'6" Hillcrest Medal.

Team NW Medal: Open to juniors and amateurs. Course will include two tests (1-19). Fences 3'6".

OHJA Medal Classes: Classes open to OHJA junior and amateur members in good standing. See OHJA Rule Book for specific information, available online at: www.oregonhunterjumper.org.

OHJA Mini Medal: Fence height not to exceed 2'6". No cross entry with 3' medals. No one or two stride in-and-outs.

OHJA Children's Medal: Fence height not to exceed 3'. Riders entered in this class may not cross enter into junior hunters, junior jumpers, or any 3'6" medal class at the same show.

OHJA Adult Medal: Fence height not to exceed 3'.

OHJA Junior Medal: Fence height 3'6".

OHJA Senior Medal: Fence height 3'6".

Adult Amateur Hunter:

To be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Horses *or* Adult Amateur riders entered in Adult Amateur Hunter sections may not compete in the Amateur Owner Hunter section at the same show. Riders may not show in any classes in which the fences are 3'9" and over at the same show. Ponies may be ridden by adults, suitability to count. Fence height not to exceed 3'. Horses and ponies NOT to jog for soundness. Age groups for awards are 18-35, 36 and over.

Children's Hunter Horse:

Open to horses to be ridden by a Junior Exhibitor. Horses *or* riders entered in the Children's Hunter section may not compete in the Junior Hunter section at the same show. Riders may not show in any classes in which the fences are 3'9" and over at the same show. Fence height not to exceed 3'. Horses NOT to jog for soundness. Children's Hunter Classics to count bonus points.

Children's Hunter Pony:

Open to ponies. Riders may not cross enter into any rated divisions. Small ponies to jump 2', Medium ponies to jump 2'3", Large ponies to jump 2'6". A year end award will be given. Ponies not to jog for soundness.

Children's/Adult Jumper: Horse and rider combinations may not cross enter in the Amateur, Amateur Owner, and Junior Jumper sections. Riders may not show in any classes where the jumps exceed 3'9". Fences to be set at 3'6" or 1.10m

Elite Jumper Year End Award:

All monies won in classes 1.30m and above and \$25,000 and higher will be calculated together for a year-end award.
