

TEAM NW COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Team NW Equestrian Sports (TNW) is pleased to be hosting two August shows. TNW is enacting the following COVID Response Plan and General COVID Protocol, in addition to the USEF Action Plan for Returning to Competition.

COVID RESPONSE PLAN:

General Precautions and Requirements under TNW and USEF Protocols

- Individuals must stay 6 feet apart (Social Distancing) and must not congregate.
- Masks/Face Coverings must be worn except when mounted (required by State of Oregon).
- Monitor temperature daily. Anyone with a temperature of 99.5 or higher should not enter the show grounds (per USEF).
- Full-Color Signage will be posted throughout the grounds regarding Social Distancing, Hand Washing, and other safety guidelines.
- TNW has a property-wide PA system, and announcements regarding these guidelines will be made throughout the event.

Specific Protocol to be followed in the case of a suspected Covid-19 individual on grounds during Competition Hours

- An individual found to have a temperature of 99.5 or higher upon entering the Show Grounds, but does not show any other symptoms of Covid-19 will be asked to leave.
- The individual should avoid contact with others and may not return to the Show Grounds until the following day, and may only return if the fever has fully dissipated and the individual has experienced no other symptoms of Covid-19.
- TNW will place on each individual a wristband indicating that their temperature has been checked and are under the 99.5 temperature threshold.
- All TNW Staff (Show Office, Jump Crew, Maintenance, Officials) will have their temperature checked upon arrival each day. Any staff member with a temperature of 99.5 or higher will be sent home.

GENERAL COVID19 PROTOCOL:

Facility

- **AS PER USEF RULES, NO SPECTATORS ALLOWED!**
- Check-in required at property Entrance.
- **With each horse, only the rider, trainer, groom, and one family member (if the rider is a minor) are allowed on show grounds as well as approved essential staff.**
- TNW will provide hand sanitizing stations throughout the premises.
- All touchpoints and common areas will be sanitized throughout the day.
- Seating will be very limited.

Food Service

- **UNFORTUNATELY THERE WILL BE NO FOOD VENDORS ON SITE.**
 - Please plan ahead and supply your own food for the day.
 - Remember, Wilsonville is only 3.5 miles away!

Daily Competition Schedule

- Time schedules will be available on horseshowtime.com each evening so exhibitors will know when their classes will be held.

Schooling / Warm-up Areas

- Only two ground persons will be allowed on a warm up jump at any time.
- Gloves should be worn by anyone setting jumps.
- Cleaning/disinfection of jumps, especially jump cups, will be regularly scheduled.

Stabling Areas

- Non-essential individuals (friends, family members, etc.) should not enter the stabling area.
- Trainers should provide an ample quantity of gloves, masks, hand sanitizer and other cleaning/disinfecting products for their staff/customers for use while on premises.
- Feed/Bedding delivery by TNW Staff will be made with as little contact as possible.

Golf Carts

- Golf Carts should not be shared. The number of people allowed on is restricted to the number of seats available.

Important USEF Regulations

While Show Management is available to address any questions or concerns on the Covid-19 Response Plan, it is important for all individuals to note the following requirements of USEF. Under USEF Rules, and as printed in the USEF Action Plan for Return to Competition: “The Competition Organizer has the authority under GR 702.1 and GR914 to remove from the facility any person who does not comply with the regulations and requirements in effect at the competition..... Participants are required to comply with these and any additional Competition Organizer requirements at all times while present on competition grounds. Failure to do so may result in expulsion from the grounds.”

COVID Emergency Warning Signs:

- Trouble breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion
- Inability to wake or stay awake
- Bluish lips or face
